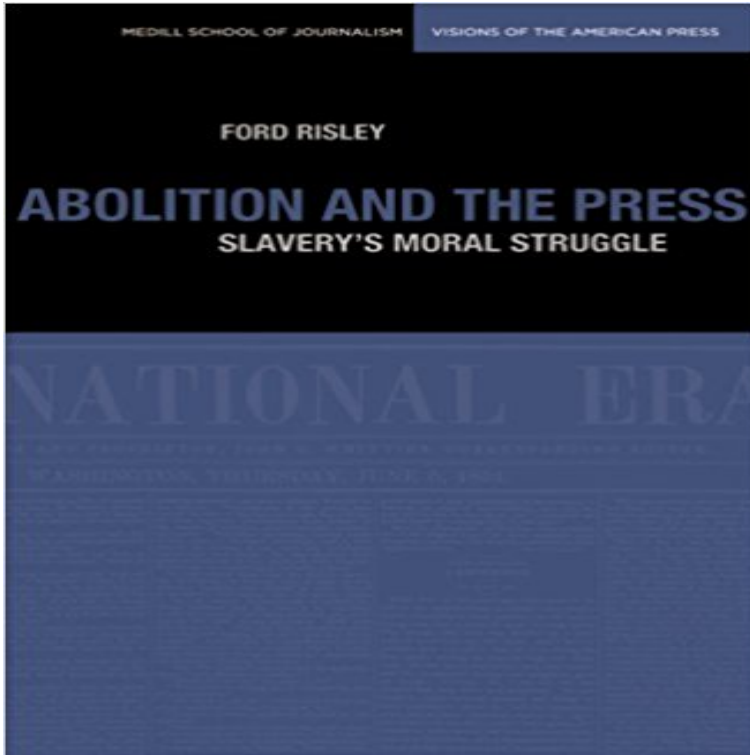


Abolition and the Press: The Moral Struggle Against Slavery (Medill School of Journalism Visions of the American Press)

These works kept the issue of slavery in the public eye even as mainstream publications took up the call for emancipation, as the nation went to war, up to the end of slavery. Their legacy has endured, as dedicated reform writers and editors continue to view the press as a vital tool in the fight for equality.
