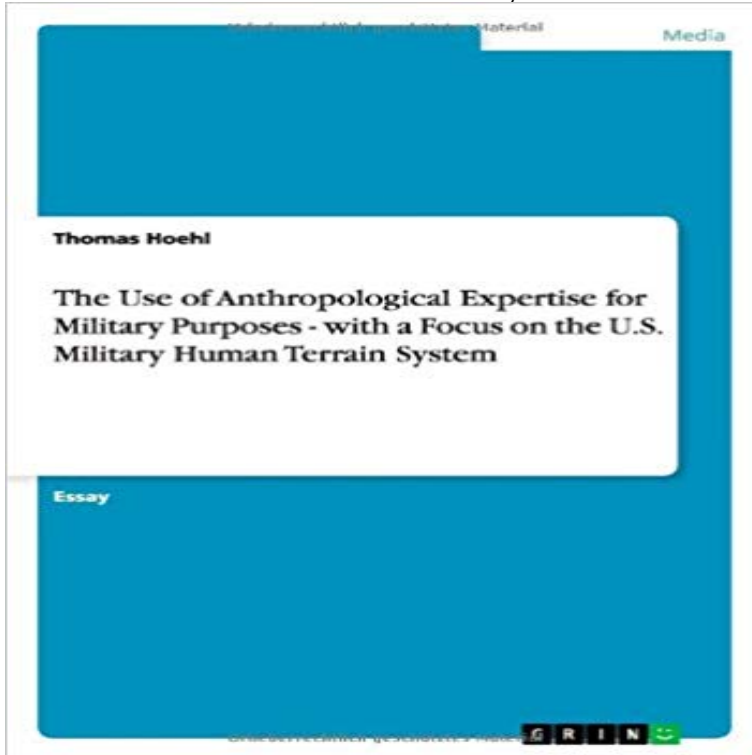


The Use of Anthropological Expertise for Military Purposes - With a Focus on the U.S. Military Human Terrain System
