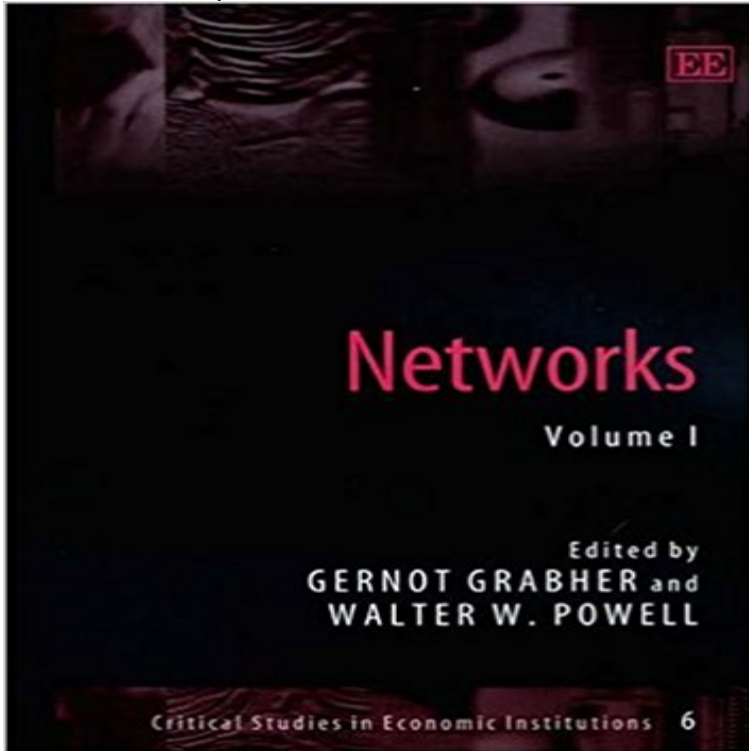


Networks (Critical Studies in Economic Institutions)
