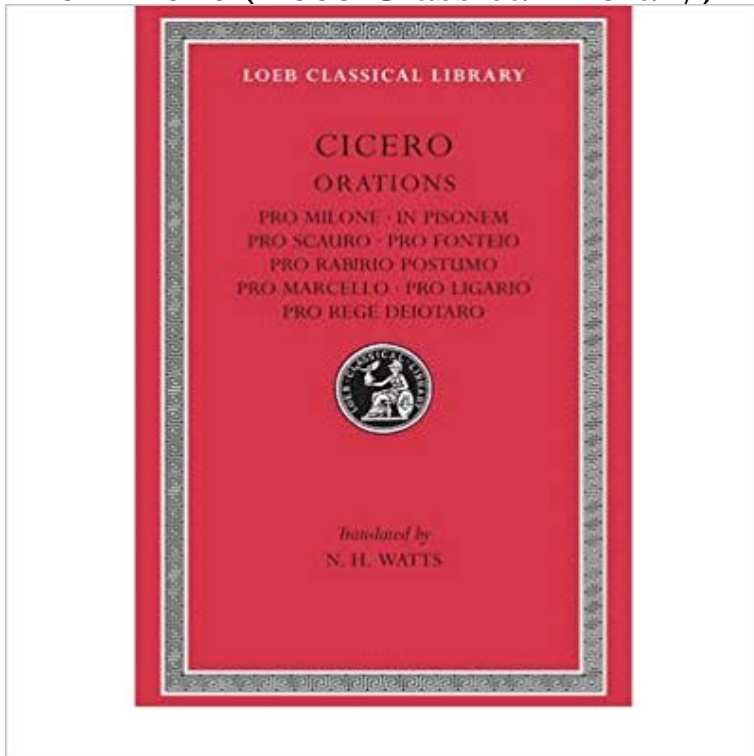


Pro Milone (Loeb Classical Library)
