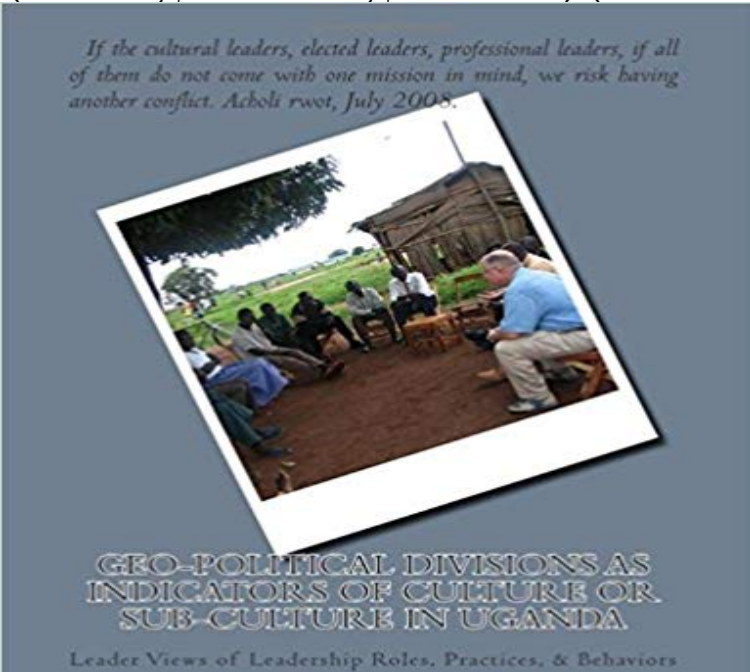


Geo-Political Divisions as Indicators of Culture or Sub-Culture in Uganda: Leader Views of Leadership Roles, Practices, & Behaviors (Leading Following Conflict) (Volume 2)



Building on a 2008 study of leadership following conflict in the Acholi Subregion of Ugandas Northern Region, the current volume compares leader perceptions of appropriate roles, practices, and behaviors among Ugandas 4 regions, 13 subregions, and 110 of 112 districts. The comparison examines statistical and practical consensus between Acholi and non-Acholi participants and between the regions, subregions, and districts. The text offers a definition of statistical consensus.
