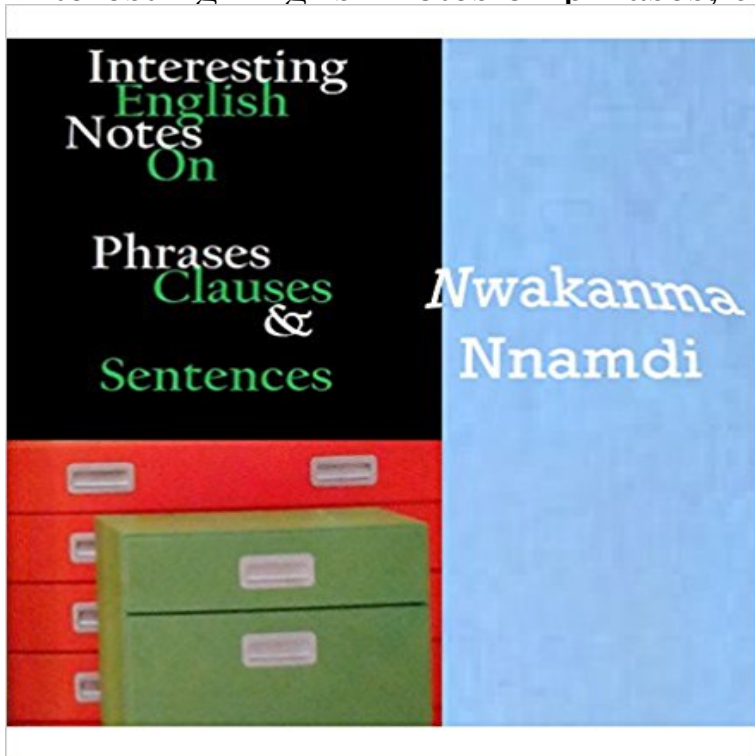


Interesting English notes on phrases, clauses & sentences
