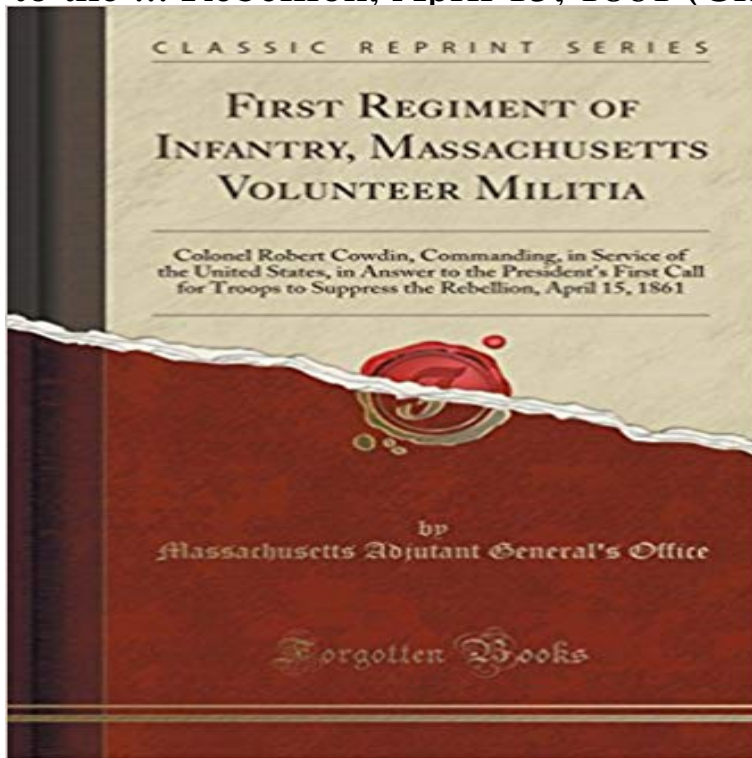

As the Forty-second Infantry, M. V. M., their recruited ranks were mustered in for service in the Depart ment Of the Gulf in 1862 - 63, and again in 1864 the regiment entered the service for honorable duty in the defences of Washington.
