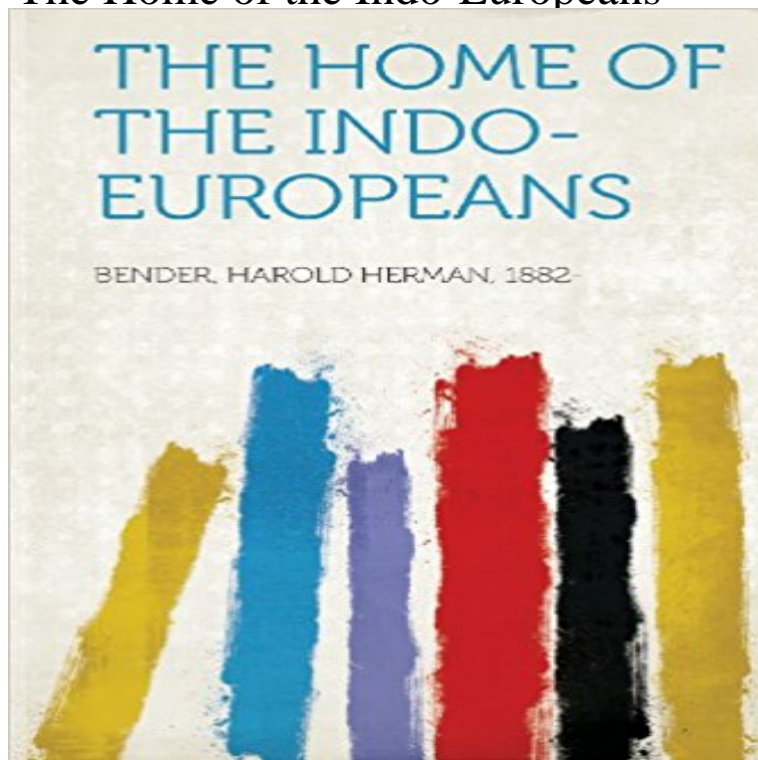


## The Home of the Indo-Europeans
