

Jankiewitsch took upon himself to alter the whole plan of Pallas swork, and, instead of pursuing the original system, which was to give the sameR ussian word in the different languages in due succession, he made an alphabetical catalogue of exotic wordsi which he explained into Russian, and in which he mixed all nations and languages together, with a view to shew how the same sounds received different meanings in different idioms. The empress was displeased, and the edition was suppressed. A few copies, however, have gone abroad, one of which is in the library of the American Philosophical Society.
