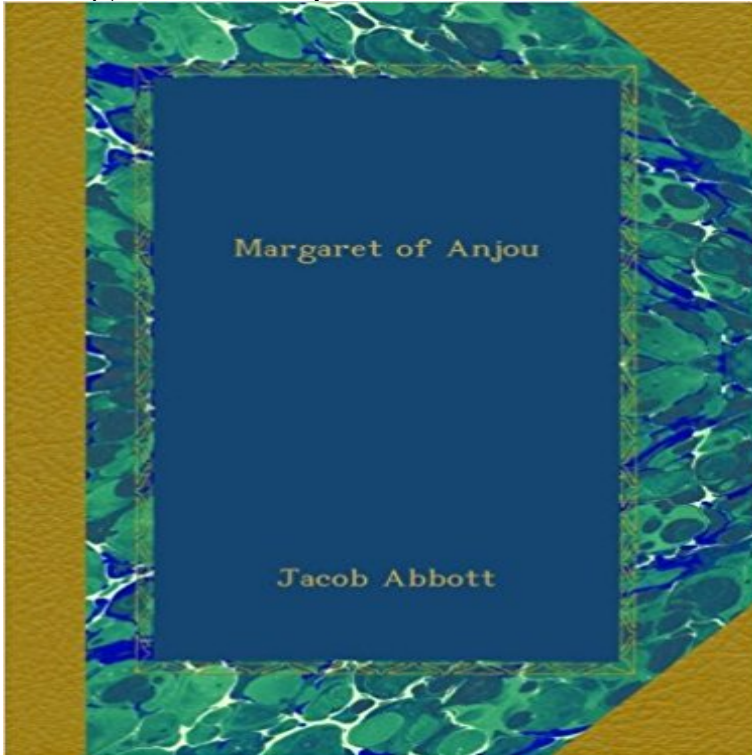


## Margaret of Anjou
