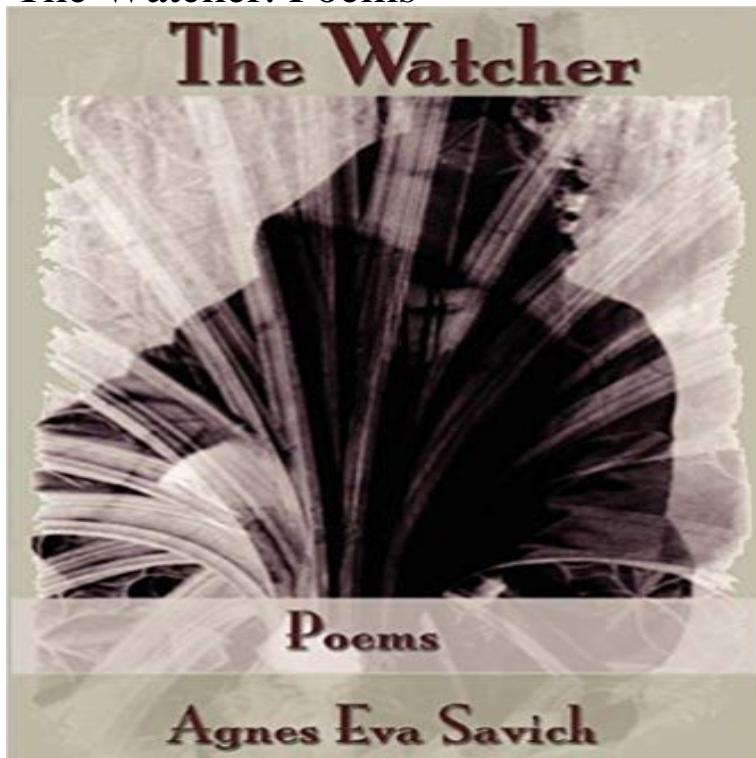


The Watcher: Poems
