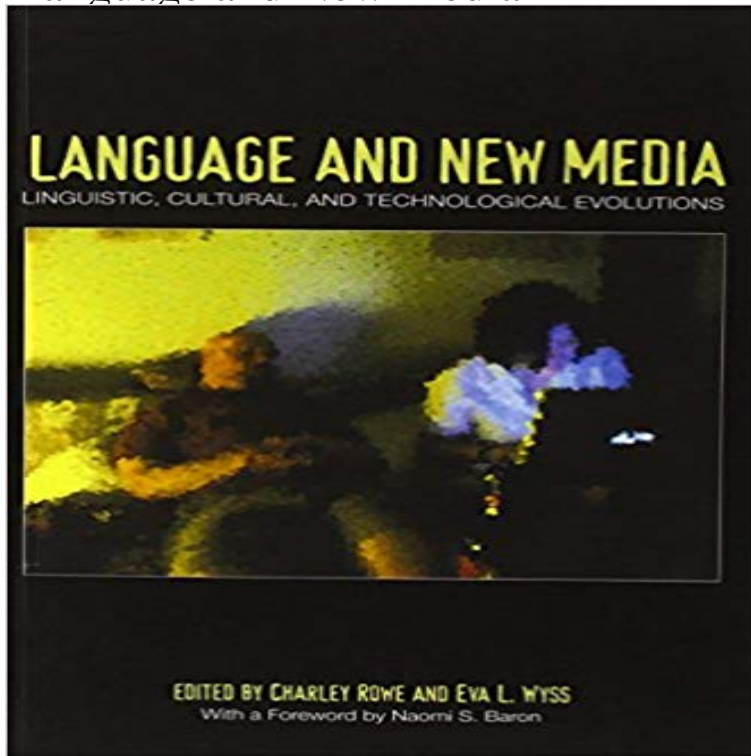


Language and New Media
