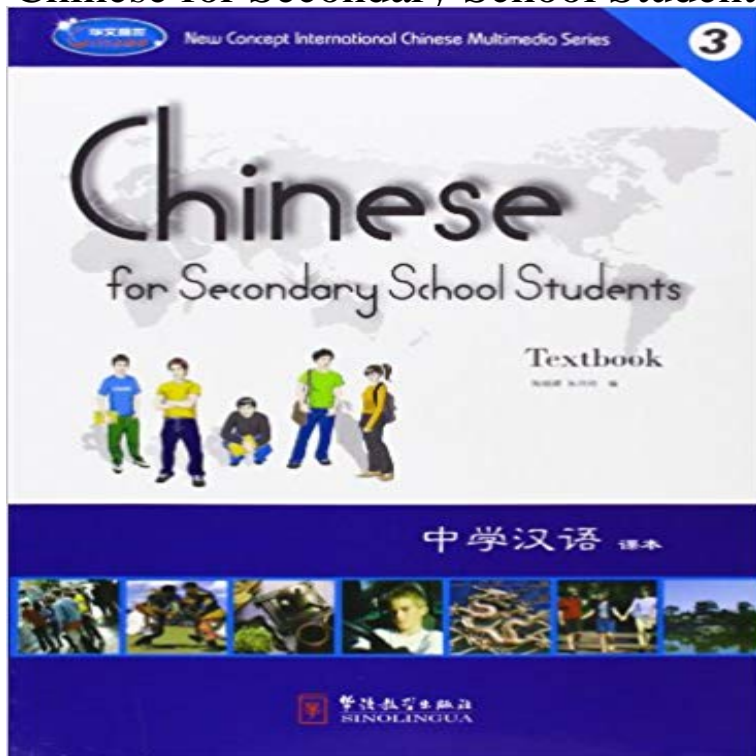


Chinese for Secondary School Students 3
