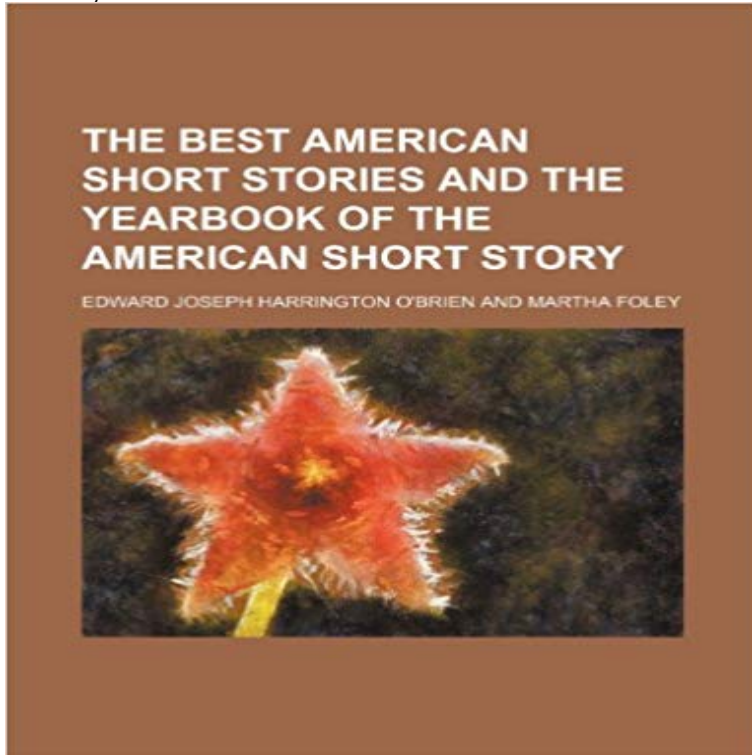


## The Best American short stories and the Yearbook of the American short story
