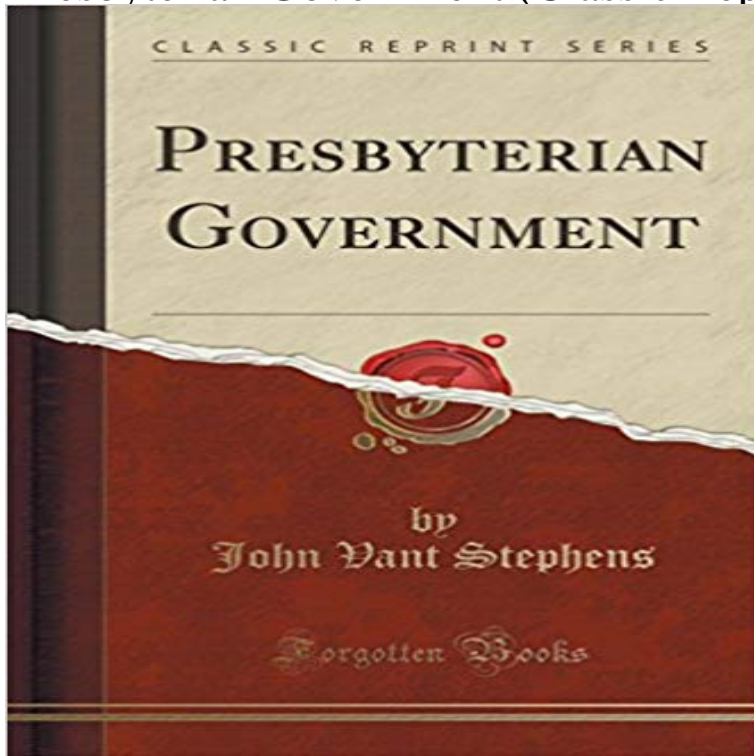


## Presbyterian Government (Classic Reprint)
