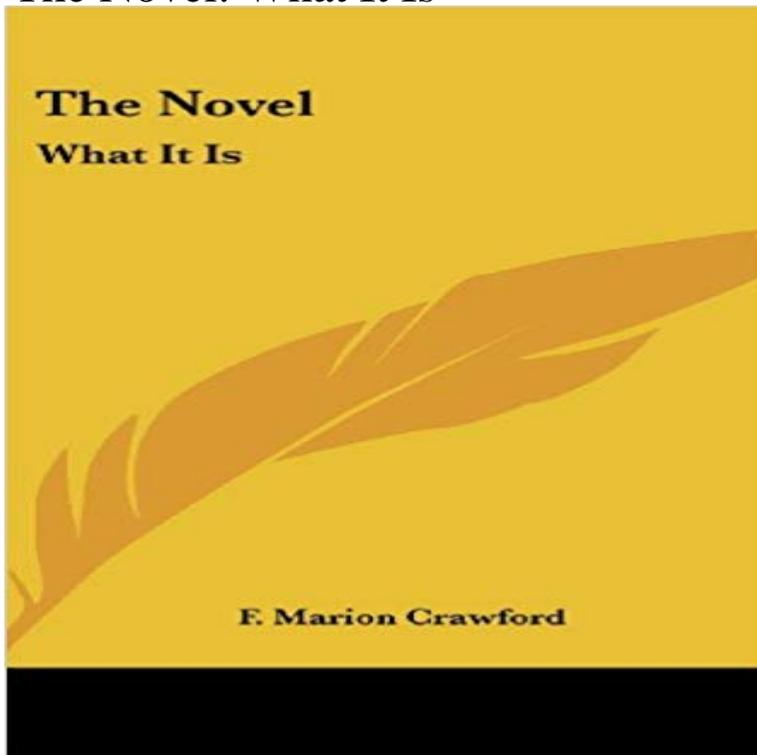


The Novel: What It Is
