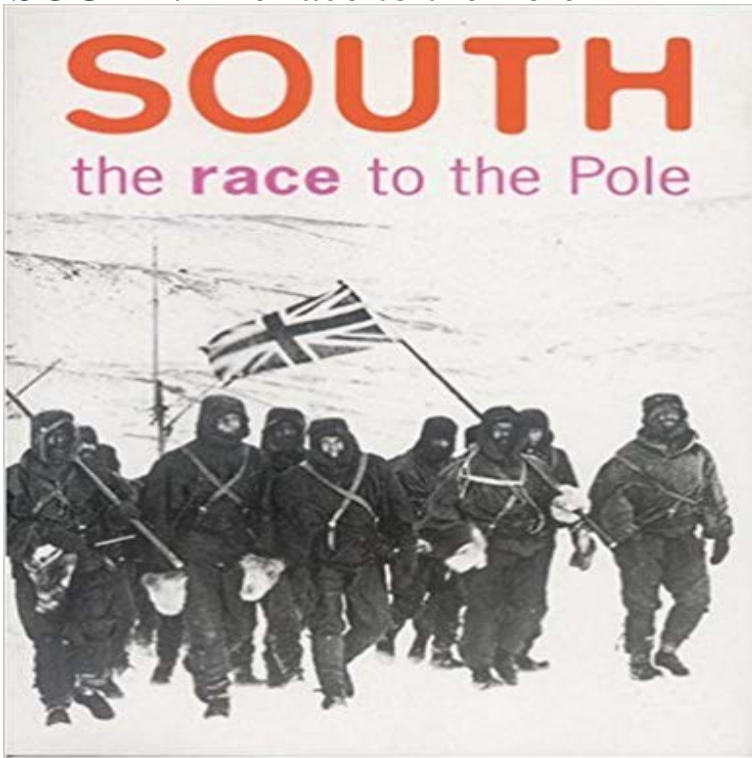


## SOUTH: The race to the Pole
