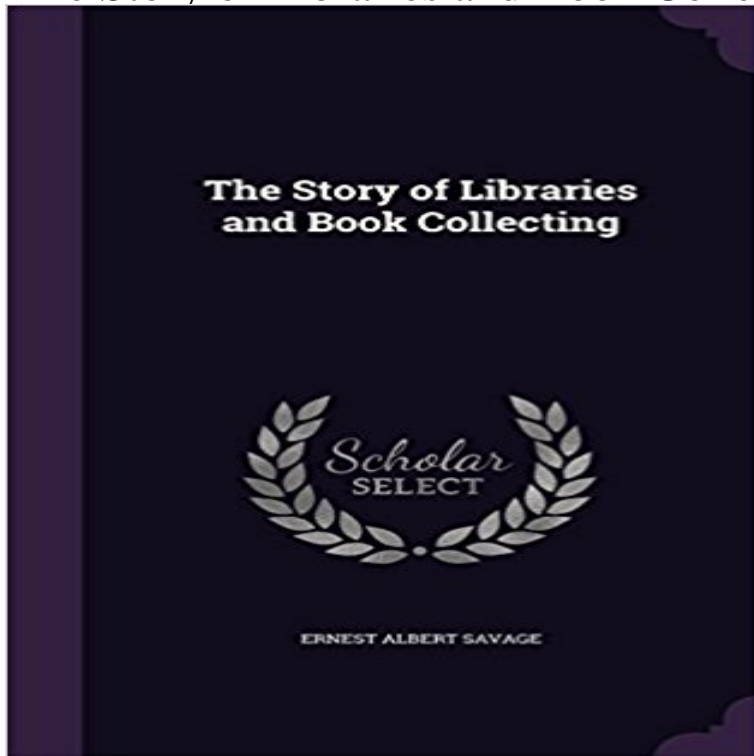


# The Story of Libraries and Book Collecting
