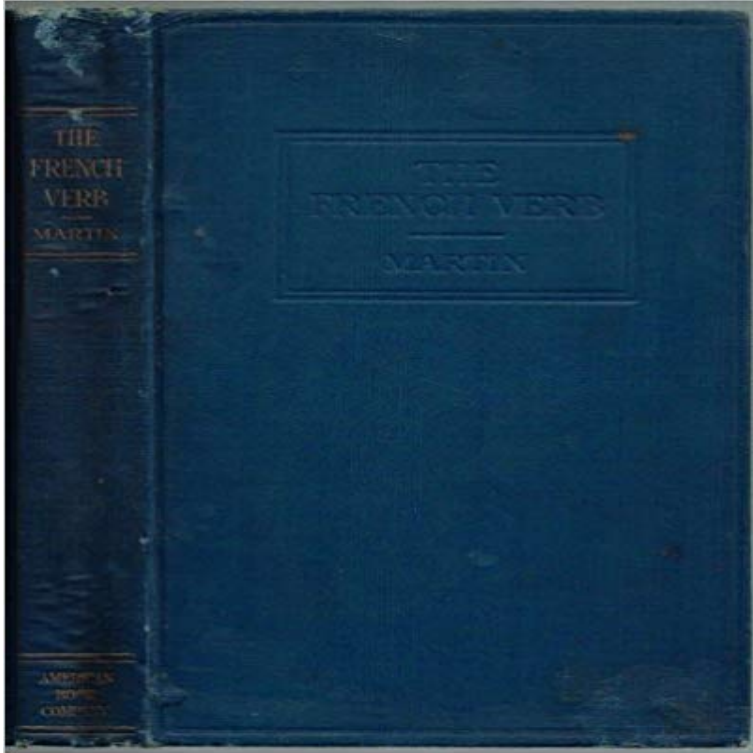


THE FRENCH VERB: ITS CONJUGATION AND IDIOMATIC USE
